## BARGAINING HIGHLIGHTS

### SERP Negotiations Update

Your Association Bargaining Team met with the District representatives. ACE, based upon the District's own documents, calculated the savings of last year's SERP to be at least **\$17,137,765.00**.

The District disagrees with ACE's calculations, yet they do not have a counter. Despite the fact that the District had 10 months to crunch the numbers, they have not calculated the savings of the SERP.

After being given ACE's data last week, the District arrived completely unprepared. The District admits that the SERP did generate savings. Ironically, the District claims they do not know how much money was saved. The District, does, however, claim that ACE's numbers are incorrect.

We hope that the District comes prepared to actually negotiate next time.
